The initial goal for foster children is reunification with their parents or biological relatives. Sometimes that is not possible, and we hope the foster family would consider becoming the child's permanent family.

- must complete a 30 hour foster parent training class
- must successfully complete a thorough background check that includes fingerprinting and a family home study
